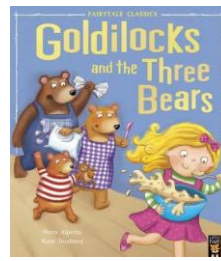
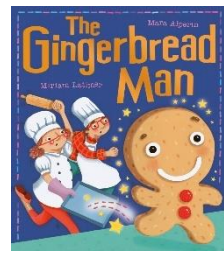
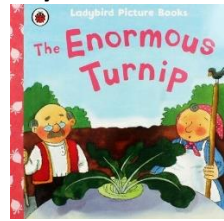

Develop social phrases.

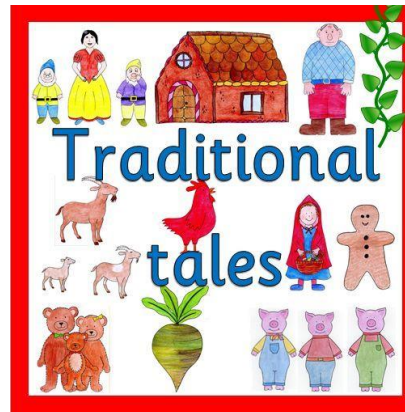
Physical Development
