Below is what your child will be learning across curriculum areas in the summer term.



History – Ancient Greece

- Describe the main changes in a period of history
- Use dates and terms accurately in describing events
- Use sources of evidence to deduce information about the past.
- Select suitable sources of evidence.
- Analyse a wide range of evidence in order to justify claims about the past.
- Understand that no single source of evidence gives the full answer to the questions about the past.
- Describe social and cultural diversity of past society.
- Describe the characteristic features of the past, including ideas, beliefs, attitudes and experiences of men, women and children.
- Compare some of the times studied with those of other areas of interest around the world



Geography- Greece and the Caribbean

- Use a range of geographical resources to give detailed descriptions and opinions of the characteristic features of a location.
- Describe and understand aspects of physical geography.
- Describe key aspects of human geography.
- Identify and describe how the physical features affect the human activity within a location.
- Describe how countries and geographical regions are interconnected and interdependent.
- Describe how locations around the world are changing and explain some reasons for change.

- Relate knowledge of plants to studies of all living things

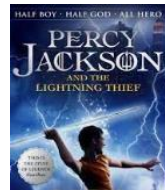
