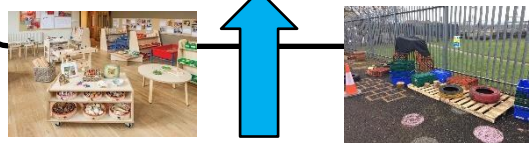
**Areas of learning**

**Environment**

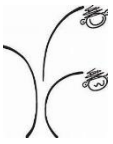
Children have access to both indoor and outdoor environments, which are set up based on needs and interests.



**Learning through play**

Through our early years our learning is mainly play based. We set up activities and the environments to suit the children's needs and interests. We ensure the timetable allows for a lot of child-initiated play, balanced with some adult led learning.

**Phonics**

Every day for 30 minutes.  
3 x Reading sessions per week.



**Objective Led Planning**

We focus on 2-3 objectives of the curriculum weekly and set up the environments accordingly.

**Snappy Maths**

Following white rose we deliver daily snappy maths sessions for 20 minutes learning a range of number, shape, space and measure skills.



**Next steps/ individual targets**

The children are all given individual next steps based off their observations.
