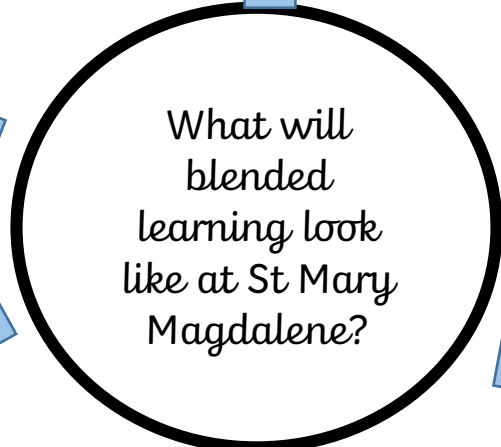
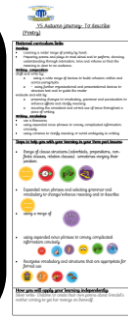
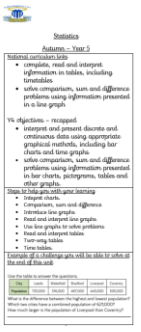


BLENDED LEARNING AT ST MARY MAGS



Our blended learning policy aims to provide all children with a quality, rounded education which develops understanding and aims to embed into long term memory. Parents will be given a sequence of lessons that mirror, as closely as possible, the learning that children will receive in school.



Seesaw will be used to set learning tasks, which the children are able to complete and then send back to staff. Staff will update these activities daily before 9am. 3-4 hours of learning will be set daily, this will include other online learning activities.



In some instances, school will be able to offer live lessons where children are able to tune into the lessons taking pace in class. This will be achieved through Microsoft Teams.



Marking policy is followed through to online learning. Children can expect daily feedback, if their work is submitted through seesaw. If work is paper based, staff will call with feedback 48 hours after it has been submitted.



Our blended learning will be differentiated to suit the needs of all children, as we would normally in the classroom. Additional resources will be sent home based where appropriate.
